## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW AND DO RIGHT NOW

At Slipstream we use a blended learning model which is the practice of using both online and hands-on learning experience. In a blended learning course, at Slipstream, we have a traditional classroom setting, that we call the **Hands-on Workshop**, where students will practice first aid and complete simulations. In addition, we have an **Online Campus** where students will learn independently, completing online components of the course, outside of the classroom, to enhance their learning potential.

## PART ONE

### SLIPSTREAM ONLINE CAMPUS

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Slipstream's Online Campus will be active within two business days of registration, allowing flexibility with a focus on the learn-at-your-own-pace model.
- Instructor interaction starts one week prior to your Hands-on Workshop and finishes when you write your final exam two weeks after your Workshop.
- You will have pre & post lesson quizzes, midterms and additional information in the Campus that will prepare you to engage in hands-on practical first aid techniques, scenarios and evacuation exercises in your Hands-on Workshop, as well as to prepare you for your online final exam.
